The Canadian Mineral Analysts (CMA) was formed in 1969 to promote the communication of analytical technologies in the Canadian mining industry. As part of this mandate, the CMA provides scholarships, up to \$1,000, to students currently enrolled in relevant programs in Canadian colleges and universities.

To be eligible to receive a CMA scholarship, a teacher, professor or supervisor (nominator) must submit a completed Scholarship Application Form for their nominated student (candidate) currently enrolled in a chemical engineering technician/technologist or analytical chemistry program (or equivalent program) at a recognized Canadian college or university.

The Scholarship Application Form will apply only to the school year in which the Application is submitted. All nominations will be evaluated by a CMA selection committee. The number of scholarships and amount of each scholarship to be awarded in any given year will be determined at the sole discretion of the CMA. Successful candidates will receive their scholarship cheque and acknowledgement letter directly from the CMA. The nominator will also receive a copy of the successful candidate's letter.

Deadline for receipt of Scholarship Application nominations for the school year is December 31st.
